The following can be practiced by adults and children in any home to uphold the commitment bond.

- I. Help with the meals, when possible, then eat it together.
- 2. Take the garbage out without being asked.
- 3. Remember to say, "I love you," often, and mean it;

not because you want something, but because you feel the love.

- 4. Share your dreams for the future. Listen to what your mate and children are saying, without interrupting or thinking of what you will say next. Don't allow your conversations to be one-sided.
- 5. Hold hands, not only in private, but also in public. The warmth of holding hands brings a lot of love and compassion between two people.
- 6. Give a surprise gift occasionally. It doesn't have to be expensive. The surprise alone will bring great joy.
- 7. Edify often and openly in front of other people.
- 8. Find things to joke and laugh about. Laughter is good medicine. Do something that is fun and spontaneous.
- 9. Never, never make plans without checking with your family members first. Always ask for their input in any decision making.
- 10. Say, "Thank you," often. Let them know that you appreciate all they do for you.
- II. Should an argument arise during the day... resolve it BEFORE going to bed. Too many times, people get so angry that they decide not to speak for days on end. This solves nothing... it only adds to the resentment of the one who is angry, not to the one they think they are trying to get even with. The old saying is, "You can catch more flies with honey than you can with a lemon." Scripture says, "Do not let the sun go down on your wrath." God told us this for a reason, He knew what would happen in your body, mind, and spirit by holding on to anger.
- 12. Buy a special card or write a love note occasionally. They don't have to be long, just honest and sincere heartfelt.
- 13. Find a project you and your family members enjoy and make time together to work at it.
- 14. Pray often together. Especially during times of crisis. Share scriptures the Lord may be showing you. Don't preach at each other, just share.



I Cup of feta cheese

2 Small boxes of frozen chopped spinach

2 Boneless skinless chicken breast

Recipe of the Month Chicken Boureki's

Ingredients:

I Stick of butter

1/2 Cup of parmesan cheese

2 Eggs

6 Slices of provolone cheese

Phyllo dough (freezer section with breads—Bi-lo or Walmart)

Defrost one sleeve in the box by putting into refrigerator overnight.

Directions:

*Melt the butter and set aside

*Cut each chicken breast into three equal pieces and set aside

- *Defrost the spinach and squeeze all the water out by hand and place the spinach in a bowl.
- *Add parmesan, feta, and eggs to the spinach and mix thoroughly with hand
- *Separate mixture in the bowl into six equal sections
- *Place I/3 of the butter evenly onto a foil lined cookie sheet and smooth out by hand if necessary
- *Place two-three Phyllo dough sheets on a DRY, flat, clean surface
- *Place one of the pieces of chicken breast onto a corner
- *Place one of the six spinach sections on top of chicken, and put one piece of provolone on top of spinach
- *Roll immediately by turning over once, folding in the sides evenly, and then continue rolling to the end.
- *Make sure the chicken is at the bottom of the roll when placed onto a foil-lined cookie sheet
- *Do not let the Boureki's touch one another. Place at least an I-2 inches between each one
- *Once all are rolled, gently rub all the remaining butter (with your hand) onto the tops of the Boureki's
- *Bake at 350 degrees for an hour or until golden brown

-NOTE: When making Spanakopita, use same spinach mixture minus the chicken and provolone... line your glass casserole dish with 1/2 the butter and place three Phyllo dough sheets in bottom; add spinach mixture about 1 to 1 1/2 inches thick, top with three sheets of Phyllo, and spread remaining butter on top with hand. Bake on 350 degrees until golden brown.



You Are Anointed!



The anointing is God's presence, His essence. It's the thing that makes God be God. The anointing is God on flesh enabling flesh (you and me) to do those things that are impossible for flesh to do.

For instance, flesh can't heal anyone. Jesus' flesh couldn't heal anyone. His flesh came from Mary. It was as human as hers. Yet, His perfect, sinless flesh speaking the words of a perfect sinless God, caused God's anointing to be upon Him without measure (John 3:34).

It's not hard for our minds to grasp the fact that the anointing was upon Jesus. What's tough to comprehend is that the same burden-removing, yoke-destroying anointing that was on Him is available to us. God counts our flesh sinless if we will stay under the blood. That is grace... giving us the anointing when we don't deserve it! Jesus, Messiah, means "anointed" and He has not withheld anything from us. That same anointing has been given to us!

Just like Jesus couldn't heal in His own flesh, neither can you. But in the anointing, Jesus did bring healing, and so can you. Everything you need to do today can be done in the Anointed One and His Anointing. His anointing is on YOU. Because of it, you have been enabled to do things you couldn't normally do.

Whether it's day to day responsibilities or laying hands on someone and releasing the healing power of God, You can be and do everything God created you to be and do in His anointing. You are anointed, set apart. Speak the Word, "I have been anointed and given an unction by the Holy One." (John 2:20)



The Origin of Father's Day

One Sunday in 1909, Sonora Smart Dodd listened to a sermon honoring mothers. Her mother had died some years before, so her father had raised her by himself. Dodd wondered why there wasn't a day to honor fathers, so she arranged a tribute to her father at a church in Spokane, Washington. The date was June 19, 1910. Many people believe this was the beginning of Father's Day.

Another account holds that a West Virginia church held a tribute service for fathers in 1908, following a mine explosion that killed 360 people. Regardless of which story is correct, President Calvin Coolidge was the first president to designate a special day to honor fathers. In 1924, he proclaimed the third Sunday in June as Father's Day.

A dad is someone who wants to catch you before you fall but instead picks you up, brushes you off, and lets you try again.


A dad is someone who wants to keep you from making mistakes but instead lets you find your own way, even though his heart breaks in silence when you get hurt.

³ In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.



JUNE is Men's Health Month! Man Up! And take control of your health!

Anchored by a Congressional health education program, Men's Health Month is celebrated across the country with screenings, health fairs, media appearances, and other health education and outreach activities. The purpose of Men's Health Month is to heighten the awareness of preventable health problems and encourage early detection and treatment of disease among men and boys. This month gives health care providers, public policy makers, the media, and individuals an opportunity to encourage men and boys to seek regular medical advice and early treatment for disease and injury. The response has been overwhelming with thousands of awareness activities in the USA and around the globe.

Health Facts:

Men die at higher rates than women from the top 10 causes of death and are the victims of over 92% of workplace deaths. (BLS)
In 1920, women lived, on average, one year longer than men. Now, men, on average, die almost five years earlier than women. (CDC)

Prevention:

Women are 100% more likely to visit the doctor for annual examinations and preventive services than men. (CDC 2001)

- 7. You'll be judged by the words you've spoken. (Matt. 12:37)



Hallelujah! It's summer!! Hopefully, schedules are freed up for most of you so we challenge you to bring your children to Sunday School. You as a parent are responsible for getting the Word into their beings. The Bible gives us the clear instruction to, "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it," - Proverbs 22:6. When you utilize a free and available time of Bible lessons, discussion, and related fun for your children, you could save them from a potential difficult teenage and adult life. We are giving them life instruction straight from the Word of God. We are here to serve our Father, and in return, to serve each one of you. Our teachers spend time in the Word and plan a lesson each Sunday. We would love and be encouraged to have you and your kids join us!

We will be continuing our lessons in the Gospel of John. Specifically this month, we will be in John 5 discussing the man at the pool of Bethesda. There was a belief in that day that this pool would make the impotent, blind, withered, and sick people well. Jesus ran into a man there who was impotent, and Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up thy bed, and walk". Do you know what happened? The man did!! Interestingly, we see that the Jews were quick to point out that the law required no one to work on the Sabbath, but Jesus said that he must pick up his bed and walk. If the impotent man stayed bound to the law, he would have never received his healing. Jesus also had a job to do on the Sabbath, and nothing was going to stop him. We are to BELIEVE and RECEIVE all of the blessings He has for us. It's time to get out of our box!

In the latter half of June, we will be discussing the four witnesses to Jesus Christ. Under the Jewish law, it was required that there be two witnesses before any evidence could be counted true, but we will learn how there were actually four witnesses that Jesus was who He said He was. Briefly, and in case you are wondering, these four witnesses are John the Baptist, Jesus' works, the Father, and the Scriptures. We will go into more detail regarding these in Sunday School. My favorite passage in this chapter is John 5:24-25, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on Him that sent e, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live." Let's start living now!

In the Bible Interaction we will discuss how our role models should walk in the truth. The Life Response will show us the ways in which we can model walking in the truth.

We can learn to live the Christian faith by walking with, listening to, and imitating God's faithful servants. Do you have any godly role models? The Shield of Faith Church and others will say that Pastor Bob and Sister Susan (Tilton) are at the top of their list of godly role models. They tell us AND show us how we are to live as Christians. They also show how we are to treat one another and how to witness to those who are lost. They are the ultimate role models of the godly character that John is talking about.



We look forward to seeing you on Sunday at 9:45am!

John said we have a choice of who we pick as our role models, and he urged his brothers in Christ to be like those who walk in the truth. God wants us to affect our world in positive ways. If we fail to embrace and follow examples of what it means to walk in the truth, we'll find our effectiveness diminished. We should not be "partners" with the world, "for you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord" (vs. 8). If we want our own lives to be models of godly character, we should look up to and follow those who walk in the truth. 
